

## **Electrical Problems**

Have you ever started up your '67 GTV, Super, or Duetto and had the generator warning light startle you by coming on bright when you rev up, but going off at idle? One member asked about it at our last club meeting and, lo and behold, four or five others had experienced the same problem (myself included). Since it seems to be a common occurrence, yours may do it tomorrow and you may want to know how to fix it. Well, the most common solution is simply to clean the ignition fuse and terminals ... you didn't know Alfas had a fuse in the ignition circuit? Oh yes - about the only car I know that does. Anyway, clean it thoroughly and bend the contacts in slightly to increase contact pressure. If that doesn't fix it (it usually will), check and clean the contacts of the wires running from the ignition switch to the voltage regulator and generator. The connectors often loosen and become corroded. Finally, failing all else, check under the backing plate of the generator - there is a wire connecting the two field coils which can rub against the generator case, wearing out the insulation and causing an intermittent short. Still can't find the problem?? Oh well - drive it (with a sigh) to Alfa Romeo Inc., 200 S. Douglas, El Segundo. Tell them AROSC sent you.
