TECHNICAL TIPS

RAINY DAY BLUES

On 71 and later model Alfas, you will notice that the coil comes equipped with a resisto. This is to insure that your coil gets the proper amount of voltage on the positive (+) side when you start your car. As resistors grow old, they tend to have a reverse effect on the coil and you will have difficulty starting your car, Wet weather, such as we've had lately, will accentuate this problem. To remedy this you can eliminate the resistor temporarily by removing the resistor and attaching the hot lead from the ignition switch (usually a light green wire) to the positive side of the coil, and the lead from the distributor (a dark green or black wire) to the

negative side of the coil. THIS IS JUST TEMPORARY. As soon as you can, replace your coil with a high output Bosch or Lucas coil which you can get locally.

Make sure all your electrical connections are tight and insure good connections by liberal applications of WD40.

Be sure to have your black plastic distributor covers in place on the late model cars.

And as always, drive safe when the road is slick!
