



Have you ever considered time trialling, but hesitated because of the expense of setting the car up if you don't know whether you'll like the speeds, be competitive, or find it more scary than fun? If you do run the time trials, do you have a family member or friend who has wondered why you do it, what it's like, and if she/he would like it too?

For all you Walter Mittys out there, and all the Ms. Mittys too, we have an offer you can't resist. In addition to our regular time trial program on July 7, we are offering a special introductory training session for first time novices. For only \$25.00, you will attend the driver's school and have a separate half-hour practice session, restricted to moderate speeds and firsttime novices only. Driving instructors will be available to lead you around the course for as many laps as you want, to but no learn how to drive the lines, other experienced or fast drivers will be on the track at that time. This will a low-pressure introduction to driving on a race track, with no worries about fast cars passing you, or pressure to go fast yourself. No times will be taken, and no trophies awarded.

Because moderate speeds will be enforced, we will allow you to run with street-prepared cars. A seat-belt is a must, and preferrably not an inertial-reel unit. The better belts you have installed, the more support you have when cornering, and the easier it is to drive. If, after this introductory session, you want to run the rest of the event, you may pay the difference in entry fees and run the rest of the program, provided that you have the full safety equipment installed.





THE GAMBLING ROUTE

DAY II Plan on leaving your home so you reach Lancaster between 6 and 7 am. For speed I recommend traveling on I-5 to 14. Early in the morning the small towns are just waking up, and their are no traffic problems to worry about. DAY IV Continue up the coast, stop off at the sea lion caves for a bumper sticker Also stop by Tilkmook for a free cheese sample and take a peek at how that famous cheese is made. Next you can stay at Sea Side a little popular resort town or cont. on over the Astoria bridge (toll) to Wash. I personally spent many a summer in this area so it is a favorite of mine. If you are a salmon fisherman, I suggest you spend the day at Ilwaco, to do some of the best ocean fishing.

DAY V Continue up 101 and take the short cut to Montesano, from the. you drive up on 12 to I-5 just below Olympia. (If you go right instead, take the next exit for a tour of the Olympia brewery) Then it is just about an 12 hour drive to Seattle.

We hope that you enjoy your trip to the Pacific Northwest and plan on spending a few days touring this area. Next month we will give you some hints of places to staying in Seattle. Hope to see you all there.
