

ALFA TIME TRIAL

The 1984 Time Trial Program is getting underway and I want you to know what's up and what we're up against.

EVENTS: We finally have our schedule from Riverside Raceway and it is not as good as it has been. We are down to 2 dates from 4 and they are not great dates at that:

February 25 April 14-15 Riverside CANCELLED Terminal Island Fun Willow Springs, VARA event

July 7 November 24 Riverside (Saturday after July 4) Riverside (Saturday after Thanksgiving)

We are sorry to have to cancel the February 11 event, but we just didn't have enough time to generate enough entries to cover the cost, as described below. We are working on developing joint events with other clubs who run time trials, and if we succeed, we should pick up another date or two. The problem is that there are only a couple of other clubs who are serious about time trialing and can put out 15 cars for us.

The February 25th event was an informal event in which VARA and AROSC were invited to take part in this "run what ya brung" event. Teri Wood talks about it in "The Alfisti Family" on mage 1



COST: Our cost to use Riverside has double to about \$2600 per event. The cost break-down is as follows:

Track use \$1000 was \$500
Track Labor \$266 was \$216
Ambulance 210 " 210
Emergency Truck 225 " n/a
Liability Ins. 450 " 375
Driver Med Ins. 450? " n/a
Total 2601 " 1301

We are going to try to get by with raising our entry fee by only \$10, to \$65. However, this means that we need 40 cars to meet expenses, not including trophies. We have been running closer to 25 cars per event, but that entry level would require a \$100 fee, which is too high for many of us. As a result, we are inviting any interested driver of any reasonable street or competion car to run with us. We would like to avoid very slow cars and very fast cars, because of the accident potential and the pure frustration of running cars with wide speed differences under limited passing rules. Please tell your friends and help hustle more entries so we can keep this program going.

We must also request that all entries be sent in (with checks) as early as possible, and no later than one week before the event. If we are too short of entries by the deadline, we will probably cancel the event to minimize our financial loss.

OTHER RIVERSIDE REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Riverside will charge all persons 12 years of age and over an entrance fee of \$5.00.
- 2. There is a mandatory muffler requirement, however, there is no allowable noise level to be met, and no checking is planned, as long as there are no excessively loud cars.
- 3. In addition to the ambulance, Riverside is providing an emergency rescue vehicle and 2 safetymen. This truck will be equipped as a fire truck with full Hurst safety equipment, including 'jaws-of-life'.

- 4. Public Liability and Property Damage Insurance coverage is increased to \$20 million.
- Driver accident insurance is now required by Riverside, and we do not yet have a firm quote, just "\$500 or less".

WORKERS: We will not hire workers, because we can't find any group willing to work a time trial for us. We will staff corners with a volunteer from each entrant -- driver, friend, or whomever. If we don't have enough non-driving workers, we will divide the practices into 2 sessions, and we'll all work one of the sessions and drive the other.

TT COMMITTEE MEETINGS: There will be regular meetings of the Time Trial Committee. Please contact me, Phyllis Gaylard, at (714) 536-2089 for information about the next meeting.

SUMMARY: Please alert any friends who may be interested in our program, and have them call me if there is any question on rules, etc. Remember, the basic safety requirements for all cars are:

- 5-point harness
- * Fire Extinguisher, securely mounted

- * Roll Bar in open cars

 * Helmet (Snell 70 or equivalent)

 * Wrist/ankle length clothing: cotton, wool, or nomex
- * Gloves of leather or nomex
- * Drive Safely

We will award trophies to Alfas and non-Alfas (if we can afford them). If you are not interested in running any events, please let me know and I'll take you off the mailing list, and save \$.20. If there is not enough interest, we'll have to give up running our own Time Trial events, and the sooner we decide, the better.
