RALLYE NEWS

ATTENTION RALLYE FANS AND ENTHUSIASTS!

This is your call to participate in the first AROSC rallye event of the year (or of the past three years to be exact!).

But wait! Before you throw down this article, let me explain to you what this event is all about. AROSC rallyes are not meant for guys from Scandinavia named Hanu or Jari who drive dual turbo, four wheel drive Group B cars and practice such driving techniques as four wheel drifts and throttle oversteer. Our rallye events are "time-speed-distance" affairs, which require the participants to follow a set of written driving instructions which guide them through a course laid out over public roads.

The object of the rallye is to follow the written instructions without getting lost while obeying all speed limits highlighted in the instructions. If you are sucssful at staying on course during the rallye, you will encounter a series of checkpoints where your elapsed time on the course will be recorded. At the end of the event, each car is scored according to it's total elapsed time as compared to the master elapsed time established by the rallyemaster. The car with the lowest difference from this master time is declared the winner.

To start our rallye season, AROSC will be participating in an event sponsored by the Santa Monica Sports Car Club. This rallye is scheduled for Friday, August 5th at 7:30PM and originates from the rear parking lot of the Bank of America Building on the corner of Sepulveda and Devonshire in the city of Mission Hills. Three classes of participants have been (which way is established: Beginner north?), Novice (watch it, there is a speed trap ahead!), and Expert (Bob, the latest info I received from the NAVSTAR satellite shows we are 0.69 seconds ahead of schedule.). The cost is only \$7.00 per car, and advance registration with AROSC is required.

"E TICKET RIDE"


Well, the cobwebs are gone and my minor injuries are healed. I would like to share the knowledge I've gained from my "wild ride" with other Time Trialers.

I'm the driver of the silver Volkswagen GTI (#106) that strayed from the track at turn 2 (at Riverside April 16th) and then proceeded to roll in the mud. Needless to saythe car was totaled but due to the safety equipment, I only received a stiff neck and a bruised left collar bone (the stiff neck from my head whipping around and the bruise from a shoulder harness strap).

The key piece of safety gear was a roll bar that had been installed just one month prior to the event. I am here to write this article because without it the roof would have caved in on one of the car's three rollovers. A roll bar is not a requirement for non-convertible time trial cars, but as this incident shows, it can be very useful. I thank my friends for their concern in insisting that I not race without a roll bar. I am now recommending that all Time Trialers give installation of a roll bar serious consideration. Yes, I did screw up and take the corner too fast. Yes, the ground might not be wet and slick-as-snot so you can't slow down. And yes, you might not be somewhat sideways when an eight inch deep ditch sucks up your left front tire and causes you to roll. BUT all those things did happen! And when "do-do" happens a roll bar is a great thing to have on your side.

The other safety gear also did it's job. The 5-point harness kept me in the seat (I landed upside-down after the rolls). The helmet protected my head (my helmet had blue interior hedliner marks on it so I did hit the roof!). Thank God (or whomever you talk to up there) that there was no fire so the driving clothes didn't have to be tested.

I sincerely want to thank Charlie Thieriot, the AROSC members who also helped



organize and run the event, and the various drivers who stopped to assist, for their serious concern for safety. I was not even out of the car before people were present. The paramedics, the corner workers, and the wrecker crew were all just super folks. I now know that we are all "in good hands" when we run with the Alfa Club!

The safety equipment was the smart thing that I did. The dumb thing was not paying attention to the speed of the car before entering a corner. The car had been modified since my last time at Riverside and was accelerating faster and handling better, both of which we know contribute to higher speeds. The combination of a higher entry speed, plus a later braking point, resulted in a larger speed increase in that corner than I was able to handle. The lesson is: "increase your speed through a corner in small amounts and don't combine a higher entry speed with less braking'.


I want to wish everybody safe Time Trials, and if you want to survive a Disneyland "E Ticket Ride", then install a roll bar!






